Things to Do

Hiking

The Pee Dee National Wildlife Refuge is a short drive North on Route 52.

Entrances to the refuge dot the highway along the way.

Fishing

The nearby Pee Dee River offers seasonal angling along its banks or from the Duke Power spillway. Lakes and streams can be found as well within the Pee Dee wildlife refuge.
